★ **Among the more** colorful characters of Leadville's golden age were H.A.W. Tabor and his second wife,Elizabeth McCourt,better known as "Baby Doe". Their history is fast becoming one of the legends of the Old West. Horace Austin Warner Tabor was a school teacher in Vermont. With his first wife and two children he left Vermont by covered wagon in 1855 to homestead in Kansas. Perhaps he did not find farming to his liking,or perhaps he was lured by rumors of fortunes to be made in Colorado mines. At any rate,a few years later he moved west to the small Colorado mining camp known as California Gulch,which he later renamed Leadville when he became its leading citizen. "Great deposits of lead are sure to be found here." he said.

As it turned out,it was silver,not lead,that was to make Leadville's fortune and wealth. Tabor knew little about mining himself,so he opened a general store,which sold everything from boots to salt,flour,and tobacco. It was

his custom to “grubstake” prospective miners, in other words, to supply them with food and supplies, or “grub”, while they looked for ore, in return for which he would get a share in the mine if one was discovered. He did this for a number of years, but no one that he aided ever found anything of value.

Finally one day in the year 1878, so the story goes, two miners came in and asked for “grub”. Tabor had decided to quit supplying it because he had lost too much money that way. These were persistent, however, and Tabor was too busy to argue with them. “Oh help yourself. One more time won’t make any difference,” he said and went on selling shoes and hats to other customers. The two miners took \$17 worth of supplies, in return for which they gave Tabor a one-third interest in their findings. They picked a barren place on the mountain side and began to dig. After nine days they struck a rich vein of silver. Tabor bought the shares of the other two men, and so the mine belonged to him alone. This mine, known as the “Pittsburgh Mine,” made 1,300,000 for Tabor in return for his \$17 investment.

Later Tabor bought the Matchless Mine on another barren hillside just outside the town for \$117,000. This turned out to be even more fabulous than the Pittsburgh, yielding \$35,000 worth of silver per day at one time. Leadville grew. Tabor became its first mayor, and later became lieutenant governor of the state.

★ For anyone who hates doing yard work,your new best friend may have arrived. A robot can autonomously shovel snow,collect leaves and cut grass.

“We’re trying to help people not spend time on yard work,” said Steven Waelbers,the designer of the robot. “We want people to enjoy their free time with their family.”

The electric robot can run by itself in right directions with the help of two beacons (信号塔) that must be placed

in the yard. The robot includes a camera and ultrasound sensor (超声传感器) that Waelbers said would stop quickly when it finds pets and people.

Owners of the robot will need to regulate the values stored in the robot. Then it will confirm the task it's going to take. Before the robot operates by itself, an owner must manually wheel it around the yard – taking it around any obstacles like trees, bushes or mailboxes. By doing this, the robot is taught how long and wide the lawn is, and won't accidentally destroy your rose bush or run to the neighborhood.

Once this setup is complete, and the \$3,999 robot has been trained on where to cut grass, rake leaves and shovel snow, it operates without any supervision.

Waelbers has always loved to build robots and play with electronics. He started work on a high-tech company after his father asked him to make a robot that would shovel snow for him. Waelbers plans to start sales in early 2017.

★ **I want to** translate the Web into every major language: every web page, every video, and, yes, even Justin Bieber's tweets.

Nowadays, most of the Web is inaccessible (不能接触的) to most people in the world because its content splits up into hundreds of languages with over 50 % of it in English. This problem is pressing, now more than ever, with millions of people from China, Russia, Latin America and other quickly developing regions entering the Web.

There are certainly systems (like Google Translate) that are improving every day at translating the gist of things written in other languages than English. Unfortunately, they are not yet accurate enough: even when what they spit out is intelligible (智能的), it's so badly written that people can't read more than a few lines before getting a headache.

This is why a new project called Duo lingo is introduced here. Duolingo aims at breaking the language barrier, and thus making the Web truly "world wide."

The idea behind Duo lingo is to kill two birds with one stone by solving both of these problems simultaneously. It is accomplished by transforming language translation into something that anyone can do - not just bilinguals - and that millions of people want to do: learning a foreign language. It is estimated that over one billion people worldwide are learning a foreign language, with millions doing so using computer programs.

With Duo lingo, people learn and translate a foreign language at the same time. When you learn on Duo lingo, the website gives you exercises set specifically for you that teach you every aspect of the new language. You may be asked to translate a sentence, to pronounce or listen to a phrase, or to describe what you see in an image. In this way, Duo lingo produces translations that are as accurate as those from professional language translators.

supposed to be. It is impossible to make your home 100% burglar-proof but there are ways to improve your home safety.

Always lock the door and windows when you go out for work or even if you are inside the house. The burglars can take advantage of the opportunity in a minute.

Be suspicious of strangers. You can never know who is pretending to conduct a research or who is using it as a disguise to see if your home is worth breaking in.

Never leave valuables or cash in visible places. Hide them out of sight because they may attract burglars.

Do not leave the door key under planters, doormats or similar hiding places. The burglars know exactly where to look for it.

Teach your children not to open the door or answer the phone when they are home alone. Although it is better to make an impression that your house is not empty, children may unintentionally reveal too much, for example, when the home is empty.

Consider installing an alarm system. A loud sound alarm usually drives the burglars away before they can steal anything from your home.

Make sure you have good lighting outside during the night. Well-lit homes are deterring the burglars because they increase the risk of being noticed while sticking around the house or trying to break in.

old. But doctors now say babies can do that on their first day of life. A baby will smile if his or her mother does something the baby likes. A baby learns to get the best care by smiling to please her mother or other caregivers. This is when babies learn to connect and “talk” with other people.

Babies really talk with caregivers by learning some language skills in the first three years when the place is rich with sounds and sights. Scientists say children should hear the speech and language of other people again and again. The first signs of communication happen during the first few days of life, when a baby learns that crying will bring food and attention.

Research shows that most children recognize the general sounds of their native language by six months of age. By that time, a baby usually begins to make sounds. By the end of their first year, most children are able to say a few simple words, although they may not understand the meaning of the words. By 18 months of age, most children are able to make simple sentences. By ages three, four and five, the number of words a child can understand quickly increases. It is at these ages that children begin to understand the rules of language.

That was mainly because children began working at an early age to help provide for the family. But with the changing times and with the cost of living getting higher every single year, having a big family is no longer considered to be a practical option. In fact, more couples consider that they have only one child and some do not have any desire to become parents at all.

According to the Australian Institute of Family Studies, by 1986, women aged 40 to 44 years, were considerably

more likely to have given birth to two children than three children (36% vs.27%) or four or more children (19%).However,taken together,women were still more likely to have had three or more children than to have had two children (46% vs.36%).

In recent years,women were more likely to have had two children than three or more children-a trend that was most marked in the most recent period (38% vs.25% in 1996; 38% vs.22% in 2006).These days,most families in Australia have two children.But the number of women who had GIVEN BIRTH TO a single child INCREASED PROGRESSIVELY from only 8% in 1981 to 13% in 2006.

The U.S.Census Bureau states that there are approximately 14 million only children in America today.This COMPRISES 20% OF the children's population COMPARED TO only 10% around fifty years ago.
