

In 2003	Parents gave children an average of 5.79 pounds (61 yuan) a week.


However, children are not too worried about it, according to the survey. Almost half of them believe they get the right amount. Only 42 percent say they would like to have more pocket money. Most kids like to compare their pocket money with their friends. In the survey, 37 percent believe their friends get more money than they do.

Although they are receiving less pocket money than before, most British kids still keep the good habit of saving, according to the survey.



By being a good listener, you can let others know that you value (重视) what they say and who they are.

You can let others know you're paying attention by looking at their eyes from time to time while they're speaking, then asking a question or two about what they're saying.

Give praise.

If you notice something you like about someone, <u>give a compliment.</u> Sharing it with him or her is a great way to start a conversation.

When giving a compliment, be honest and true. Even if you compliment someone on something very small-like the color of the person's shoes, he or she will be very glad to hear it.

Keep yourself from the mobile phone.

Put away your phone and take a look around. Who seems funny or interesting? Which people in the room have you never talked to? Remember these people and spend a little time getting to know them face to face.

Join a club or team.

Having an interest in common with another person gives both of you something to talk about. You can join clubs, teams or other groups.
