- o mingle ['mingl]
- o vt.
 - □ 使混合,使掺和,使相混: She looked at him, love and disgust mingled on her face. 她望着他,脸上露出爱与恨交织的表情。
 - □ 使结合, 使联合: The colours don't mingle well. 这些颜色不宜混合。
 - □ The colour of red and blue are mingled by the boy. 红色和蓝色被这个小孩混在了一起。

o vi.

- □ 混合起来,相混合: The various sounds mingled pleasantly. 各种不同的声音悦耳地交织在一起。
- □ If we mingle with the crowd, we shall not be noticed 如果我们混在人群里,就不会被注意到了。
- □ 相交往; 相往来:

He used to train in a local park and mingle with other runners. 他过去常在地方公园里锻炼,并与其他跑步的人相交往。

Q: He rarely mingles with other students on the campus.



- Entertain vt.
- o 给···娱乐,助兴;使欢乐,使快乐,使喜悦;使有兴趣: to entertain children with funny stories.给孩子们讲有趣的故事
- o 招待,款待,请(客): They do most of their entertaining in restaurants.他们多数都在餐馆请客。
- o 愿意考虑(想法、疑心等): She never entertained such ideas.她 从不考虑这样的想法。
- o 心存, 怀着, 怀抱, 抱有(希望、信心、观点、意见等): He secretly entertained thoughts of revenge. 他暗中怀有报复的想法。
- Entertain vi.
- o 招待,款待,请客: We loved to talk, dance and entertain我们喜爱谈话、跳舞和请客。
- Q: Can you tell me something about how you entertain yourself?

- Clue n. (解决问题的)线索;提示;暗示;迹象 vt.
 - □ 暗示; 提示; 为…提供线索: Nobody clued us to this mystery.

没有人向我们提供解开这个奥秘的线索。

- □ 为…提供必要的消息: Please clue us to what happened. 请将 发生的情况详细地告诉我们。
- □ do not have a clue 一无所知;毫无头绪;一点不懂
- □ get a clue 得到线索,洞察,注意,理解,领会,明白,觉察到

o proceed [prəu'si:d] vi.

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- 进行,前进(尤指停止后继续进行): Work is proceeding slowly.工作正在慢慢地继续进行着。
- o(尤指打断后)继续说;继续讲下去: He paused to consult his notes, and then proceeded with his question. 他停了下来看了看笔记,然后继续提问。
- ○开始;从事;着手: to proceed from objective realities 从客观实际出发
- ○推进;进行: a project that is proceeding well进行 得很顺利的工程

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
