## 1.appealing

appealing 有吸引力的

### 【意思】

“Appealing”是形容词，意思是“有吸引力的”或“动人的”。它常用来描述某事或某物使人感兴趣或有魅力的特质。

### 【用法】

“Appealing”通常用于形容事物、场景、外观、提议等能引起他人兴趣的性质。

### 【常用短语结构】

1.appealing to (someone) - 吸引某人

2.appealing idea - 吸引人的想法

3.appealing design - 吸引人的设计

4.appealing features - 吸引人的特点

### 【例句】

1.The new student is very appealing to everyone in the class. 新来的学生对班里的每个人都很有吸引力。

2.The colorful decorations made the classroom more appealing. 五颜六色的装饰使教室更有吸引力。

“Impressive”可以用来形容人、事件、成就、表演、建筑等，使人感到震撼或钦佩。

### 【常用短语结构】

1.impressive performance - 令人印象深刻的表现

2.impressive results - 令人赞叹的结果

3.impressive skills - 令人钦佩的技能

4.impressive achievements - 令人骄傲的成就

5.impressive speech - 令人印象深刻的演讲

### 【例句】

1.The student's impressive presentation won first place in the competition. 这位学生的精彩演讲在比赛中获得了第一名。

2. striking features - 引人注目的特征
3. striking resemblance - 惊人的相似
4. striking appearance - 引人注目的外表
5. striking results - 显著的结果

**【例句】**

“**Intriguing**”常用来形容故事、问题、人物、思想等，使人感到好奇或想要深入了解。

##### 【常用短语结构】

1. intriguing story - 引人入胜的故事
2. intriguing question - 令人好奇的问题
3. intriguing idea - 有趣的想法
4. intriguing character - 引人注目的人物
5. intriguing facts - 引人入胜的事实

##### 【例句】

1.remarkably successful - 非常成功

2.remarkably talented - 异常有才华

3.remarkably similar - 非常相似

4.remarkably effective - 非常有效

5.remarkably easy - 非常简单

### 【例句】

1.The student performed remarkably well on the math test. 这位学生在数学考试中表现得非常出色。

2.She is remarkably talented in playing the piano. 她在钢琴演奏方面异常有才华。

5.consistently performs - 一直表现

5.assist in learning - 帮助学习

2.significant impact - 重大影响

3.significant role - 重要角色

4.significant difference - 显著差异

5.significant improvement - 显著改善
