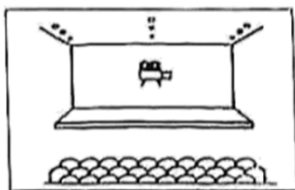

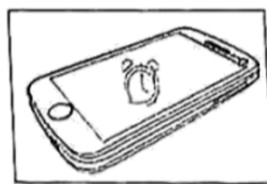

Exams help teachers see what kids know, but some say it's time to stop the clock

Students in the US are regularly tested on their knowledge of class materials, from midterms to finals. Traditionally, educators have put time limits on tests _____ 45 _____ they believe it's fair to give most students the same amount of time, and they also think students who really know the material should be able to answer all the questions during that time. Studies

have shown, however, that the 46 to take a test quickly doesn't reflect (反映) a student's intelligence or knowledge of the material. Timed tests simply favour (有利于) students who can think under pressure. What do you think? Should we get rid of timed tests?

Yes—having a time limit on tests can be unfair

Time limits on tests give an advantage to students who can think quickly and stay calm. That has 47 to do with how much they know or how much they've studied. Many students, including people with learning difficulties, need more time to focus on their thoughts. They can get stressed and anxious (焦虑的) and even have trouble sleeping the night before a test, which will affect their performance. Not everyone can express his ideas or knowledge while the clock is ticking. Studies show that when students have time to focus on the questions, they give more thoughtful answers and 48 remember the material better.

No—it's important to have time limits on tests

Giving students the same test with the same time limit is a fair way to test and compare their knowledge and abilities. While some students may need extra time due to specific needs, not everyone does. 49 there is a time limit for students to finish a test, they won't learn how to manage their time or decide how much time to spend on each question. Time limits encourage students to trust their knowledge, make decisions and move forward, which helps build 50.

Learning to work efficiently and quickly is also important in the real world, including in the workplace.

She's amazed by how s____55____ they are and teaches them different tricks, like recognizing parts of their bodies and even painting with a brush. Whenever Amy talks to zoo visitors, she points out how each giraffe is s____56____. "To people who don't know them, all giraffes look alike. But I see them every day, each giraffe has a different face, way of walking and moving, body shape and markings." she says.

Amy not only cares for the giraffes in the zoo, but also p____57____ those in the wild. She works as a researcher to make sure the long-term survival of Africa's giraffes. Besides she raises money for the Wild Animal Foundation (野生动物基金会) on World Giraffe Day every year.

Dear Jason,

You must be feeling very stressed these days. I'm glad you wrote to me for help. However, you should keep calm and talk to your parents about the benefits of your hobby. I can see why your parents are against video-gaming—it was seen as a useless pastime (娱乐活动) back in the time when your parents were young. The best idea may be to tell them that it is good training for new tech jobs like being a video game developer or drone photographer (无人机摄影师). Also, it is a good way to have a rest after a long school day. Try pointing out real-life examples to them to support your idea. Meanwhile, you should also make sure your hobby doesn't get in the way of your school performance.

As for your parents' not allowing you to go out with your friends, it may be a good idea to open up to them about your private life. For example, you can _____. This may help them change their mind. Meanwhile, show them you are a responsible person who understands their worries, and will not let them down. If you can do this, I don't believe they will be so hard on you. Remember, you mustn't lose your cool, as that would be immature (不成熟的).

【详解】句意：大卫去东方明珠电视塔的想法与我的想法不一致。

考查代词辨析。I 我，主格人称代词；me 我，宾格人称代词；my 我的，形容词性物主代词；mine 我的，名词性物主代词。根据“David's idea to go to the Oriental Pearl TV Tower”可知，此处指的是想法不同，此处应该填入 mine “我的”，名词性物主代词，指代我去东方明珠电视塔的想法，作宾语。故选 D。

【答案】A

【详解】句意：在吃了两个粽子后，这个饥饿的男孩又要了另一个。

考查不定代词辨析。another 又一（三者及以上），后跟单数可数名词；other 其他的；others 其他的人或物；the other 两者中的另一个。根据“After eating two rice dumplings”可知，是吃了两个之后，又要了一个，应用 another。故选 A。

【答案】B

【详解】句意：来自国内外的游客在黄浦江两岸观赏到了美妙的景色。

考查代词。none 没有，表示三者或三者以上；both 两者都；all 三者及三者以上都；neither 两者都不。根据“...sides of the Huangpu River”可知，是指黄浦江两岸。故选 B。

【答案】A

【详解】句意：穿蓝色的男子看起来友好因为他总是带着笑和他人说话。

考查形容词作表语。friendly 形容词，友好的；gently 副词，温柔地；sadly 副词悲伤地；lonely 形容词，孤独的。根据 seem 是系动词，所以横线上是形容词，排除 BC，由于“talks to others with a smile”，可知是友好的。故选 A。

【答案】C

考查情态动词辨析。can't 不可能；shouldn't 不应该；needn't 不需要，不必；mustn't 禁止。根据提问“must I get everything ready for the discussion...”以及回答“No...”可知，此处应用 needn't，表示“不需要”。故选 C。

【答案】B

【详解】句意：在老师的帮助下，那个小女孩和她同桌一样快地解出了这道数学题。

考查比较级用法。quick 快速的；quickly 快速地；quicker 更快的；more quickly 更快地。根据“...little girl worked out the maths problem as...as her deskmate did.”可知，考查 as+adj./adv.+as“和……一样”，中间用原级。此处需填副词，修饰动词 worked out，表示很快地解题。故选 B。

【答案】D

【详解】句意：到去年底，Kevin 已经在上海住了十年了。

考查动词时态。根据“By the end of last year”和“for ten years.”可知是表示动作从过去持续到去年，应用过去完成时 had done。故选 D。

【答案】A

【详解】句意：昨天的这个时候，我妹妹正在公园里开心地放风筝。

考查时态。was flying 过去进行时；flew 一般过去时；had flown 过去完成时；would fly 过去将来时。根据“this time yesterday”可知，强调过去动作发生的具体时间点，应使用过去进行时。故选 A。
