Most of us had no idea what to expect last Monday. Our teachers told us that it was School Poetry Week. The whole school would see a show called Poetry Play.

When we got to the hall, we saw a big box in the middle of the stage. A man was sitting on it. After everyone sat down, the man stood up. He started pulling up the sail on a ship. There was no ship. There was no rope. He didn't say anything. But we could understand exactly what he was doing. We all got very quiet and watched. Soon he was sailing on the sea. He began speaking, "If I had a ship, I'd sail my ship." He was reciting *The Island*, a poem by A. A. Milne.

By then we knew that Peter Williams, the man on the stage, was going to give us a great performance. Between poems, he often lifted the lid (盖子) of the box and put his head inside. When he came out, he had changed into a different character by putting on a funny nose or a hat. First he was a silly guy with big red cheeks and a round nose. Then he turned into a very proper English gentleman. Next he was a cat. With each change he used a different voice. Williams was truly amazing. He became five different characters and recited more than twenty poems in all.

His performance of *Jabberwocky* by Lewis Carroll was one of the best parts of the show. The poem is filled with made-up words. No one knows exactly what they mean. But when Peter Williams acted out the poem, it

became an exciting experience.

Williams was often very funny. But he was serious, too. He really showed how poems can fit every mood. He told us that we should say poems out loud. We should all try to learn some poems by heart. He left us with these words from a poem by Beatrice Schenk de Regniers, “Keep a poem in your pocket.”

If you visit our school today, you’ll see that Peter Williams’ words come to life. In every room you will hear people reading poems out loud. Ask anyone what his or her favourite poem is. Your friend will probably start reciting (背诵) it!

B

The song Happy Birthday to You is an example of just how interesting the world is. Think about this song-it is only 6 notes. Yet it is one of the best-known songs in the world. It was written in 1893 by Mildred and Patty Hill and first published with the words, “Good morning to you”.

The words “Happy Birthday to You” were first seen in print in 1924, although the author is unknown. The Clayton F. Summy Company became the song’s publisher in 1935. Through a series of purchases and acquisitions (收购), the song now belongs to AOL Time Warner. ASCAP represents the song for public performance licensing.

The copyright to Happy Birthday to You should have expired (过期) in 1991, but copyright Act of 1976 extended (延长) it, and the Copyright Term Extension Act of 1998 extended it again, so the song is protected until 2030 at least.

Happy Birthday to You brings in about \$ 2 million per year. If you ever hear the song in a movie, TV show or an ad, a licensing fee has been paid. Any manufacturer that plays the song pays a licensing. The manufacturer of any musical card playing the songs pays a licensing fee. This 6-note song is a big business!

In 1927, he found the story he wanted. It was the book Show Boat by American writer Edna Ferber. Kern died in 1945. But the musical play show Boat has been performed thousands of times all over the world.

【答案】(p)raise

【详解】句意：这首伟大的歌曲赢得了全国人民的高度赞扬。根据“This great song won high p...from people all over our country.”可知，这首伟大的歌曲赢得了全国人民的高度赞扬，praise“赞扬”符合语境，故填(p)raise。

3. The conflict(冲突) between Russia and Ukraine has l\_\_\_\_\_ for over two months.

【答案】(l)asted

【详解】句意：俄罗斯和乌克兰之间的冲突已经持续了两个多月。根据“The conflict(冲突) between Russia and Ukraine has l...for over two months.”及首字母可知，表示冲突持续，last“持续”，此处是现在完成时，动词用过去分词形式。故填(l)asted。

【答案】(c)reate

【详解】句意：政府计划为年轻人创造更多的就业机会。根据“The government plans to c...more jobs for the young.”可知，是创造更多的就业机会，create“创造”，plan to do sth“计划做某事”，故填(c)reate。

【答案】(t)alent

【详解】句意：她有唱歌的天赋。她在许多歌唱比赛中获胜。根据“She's won many singing competitions.”可知，她有唱歌的天赋，have talent for“有.....天赋”。故填(t)alent。

【详解】句意：陈先生将为简的辛勤工作颁奖。根据“颁奖”可知，此处指 present the prize“颁奖”，will+动词原形。故填(p)resent。

【详解】句意：中国政府正尝试控制不断上涨的房价。根据“the rising house costs”可知房价不断上涨，政府在试图控制房价，control“控制”；try to 后跟动词原形。故填(c)ontrol。

【答案】(m)usician

【详解】句意：这位著名的音乐家很快将要来中国。根据句意和首字母可知，此处使用 musician“音乐家”，可数名词，根据“The”可知，此处使用名词单数，表示特指。故填(m)usician。

9. My best friend sent me a beautiful g\_\_\_\_\_ on my birthday.

【答案】(g)ift

【详解】句意：我最好的朋友在我生日那天送了我一份漂亮的礼物。根据“My best friend sent me a beautiful...on my birthday”以及首字母可知，生日时朋友会送礼物，不定冠词 a 后加名词单数 gift“礼物”。故填(g)ift。

10. The Spring Festival is one of the most important t\_\_\_\_\_ festivals in China.

【答案】(t)raditional

【详解】句意：春节是中国最重要的传统节日之一。根据“The Spring Festival is one of the most important t...festivals in China.”可知，春季是中国传统的节日。“传统的”traditional，是形容词，在句中修饰名词“festivals”。故填(t)raditional。

【详解】句意：作为传统服装，旗袍展现了中国服饰文化。根据“As ... clothing,”可知，空处用形容词 traditional“传统的”作定语。故填 traditional。

【详解】句意：卫生官员已经成功地控制了病毒的传播。根据“have...controlled”可知此处应填副词修饰动词，success 的副词形式是 successfully。故填 successfully。

【详解】句意：我住在伦敦市中心，非常方便。因为空前“London 伦敦”为名词，所以此空需填形容词作定语，centre 的形容词形式为 central“中心的”，故填 central。

【答案】 valuable

【详解】句意：任何可以使任务完成的决定都会被认为是很有价值的。此空位于 be 动词后作表语，应用“value”的形容词“valuable”，表示“有价值的”。故填 valuable。

【答案】 to build/build

【详解】句意：志愿者们帮助在那个村子里建了一所学校。build“建造”，是动词，固定短语 help sb. (to) do sth.“帮助某人做某事”，故填(to) build。

【答案】 lasting
