both...and...意为".....和.....都",用于连接两个并列关系的成分。当both...and...连接两个并列的名词活代词作主语时,谓语动词用<mark>复数</mark>形式。Both Hangzhou and Suzhou are beautiful cities.

杭州和苏州都是美丽的城市。

[拓展]与both...and... 相对的短语是neither...nor..., 意为"既不……也不 ....."。

Neither Lucy nor Jenny understands Beijing Opera. 露西和詹妮都不懂京剧。 3. When Chinese people eat out in restaurants, they may take turns paying for the meal.


