This project looks at how people talk in 1,712 places. Their languages include 103 dialects that are almost gone. It has helpedChina to build the lar gest language resource library in the world. There's an online library where people can lear n dialects from over 5. 6 million audio clips and over 5 million videos.

Scholar Zhang Hongming talked about his concerns about the disuppearing of dialects. Zheng has been playing the erhu since she was 9. and she has won prizes in many national music competitions. Zheng arrived in I taly in 2021. Since April 2023, she has been performing on the stre et during her free time. And now she does three or four street show s a month.


