



On the other hand, AI will also create many 24 jobs for people. More people will be needed to write programs for AI systems and they will work on them, too.

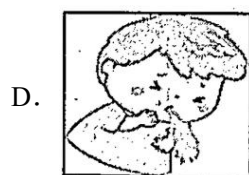
News of Timothy's actions was the talk of Ramer Elementary School. The Brandi Wardlow in that school put the poster up in the lunchroom and every classroom 14 years ago. Her hope was that students would pay attention and maybe some day, save a life.

"We never know when they're watching or what they're paying attention to," Wardlow said. "This little poster here has saved his cousin's life. It's amazing. It shows that a knowledge of first aid can make a real difference."

In Lymington, UK, Brockenhurst College offers a program to help students at Priestlands School learn Chinese. It is warmly welcomed by the young students.
