

When 9-year-old Timothy noticed his 5-year-old cousin Conner choking (噎住) on a candy recently, he took action at once and saved Conner's life by himself.

They were watching TV with Timothy's grandparents when Conner started choking. "He was just crying and holding his throat," Timothy said. "Our grandma had him upside down (倒转) and our grandpa was patting (拍) his back. But they didn't work."

Thanks to a poster put up in his school, Timothy remembered what he had seen on the poster at school. He stood behind his cousin and he started the Heimlich maneuver (海姆立克急救法). "I took him, and I started to push his stomach, like this," Timothy said. After a few minutes, the candy came out of Conner's throat. I never thought I'd need to use my first-aid skills so soon, but I'm very glad I knew what to do. The Heimlich maneuver worked perfectly! I'm proud of what I did."

News of Timothy's actions was the talk of Ramer Elementary School. The Brandi Wardlow in that school put the poster up in the lunchroom and every classroom 14 years ago. Her hope was that students would pay attention and maybe some day, save a life.

"We never know when they're watching or what they're paying attention to," Wardlow said.

"This little poster here has saved his cousin's life. It's amazing. It shows that a knowledge of first aid can make a real difference."

In Lymington, UK, Brockenhurst College offers a program to help students at Priestlands School learn Chinese. It is warmly welcomed by the young students.

Because China is having an increasingly worldwide effect, it is no surprise that young people in many countries are jumping at all the chances they can get to learn Chinese. In Priestlands School, sixty students from Years 7 to 10 applied (申请) for just 30 places studying Chinese after school.


How to help improve this situation? One possible way was to choose the soil from the younger geological areas on the moon and to create a better planting environment.


