- To make conversation.

- You told her a new play was coming to 'the Globe' soon, didn't you?
- Yes, I did.

Comprehension questions

- Did you ask her if she'd be seeing it?
- Yes, I did.

Comprehension questions

- What did she reply?
- 'No.'

- What did you ask her next?
- Whether she would be spending her holidays abroad this year.

tight (1.2) /taɪt/ *adj.* 紧身的

fix (1.4) /fiks/ *v.* 凝视

globe (1.6) /gləʊb/ *n.* 地球

despair (1.13) /dɪ'speə/ *n.* 绝望

New words and expressions

hostess n.

- a woman at a party, meal etc who has invited all the guests and provides them with food, drink etc
- 女主人
- Host 男主人

New words and expressions

- The **hostess** introduced them.



New words and expressions

unsmiling adj.

- looking serious and unfriendly
- 不笑的，严肃的

New words and expressions

- He was **unsmiling** and silent.



New words and expressions

tight adj.

- tight clothes fit your body very closely, especially in a way that is uncomfortable
- 紧身的

New words and expressions

- My shoes were so **tight** that I could hardly walk.



New words and expressions

- The bandage(绷带) must be **tight** enough
- to stop the bleeding.
