

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

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# Listening comprehension skills



### **Comprehension of main ideas**

The ability to understand the overall message or point of a spoken passage, including the introduction, conclusion, and main points.

### **Recognition of important details**

The ability to listen for and understand specific details or information that are important for comprehension, such as names, dates, locations, and events.

### **Understanding of speaker's intention**

The ability to infer the speaker's intention or purpose in saying something, based on the context and content of the message.

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# Listening note taking skills



## **Organized note taking**

The ability to take notes that are organized and structured, with headings, subheadings, and bullet points to aid in comprehension and回忆.

## Selective note taking

The ability to identify and record only the most important or relevant information from a spoken passage, leaving out unnecessary details.



## **Recognition of key phrases**

The ability to listen for and record key phrases or sentences that are significant for comprehension or future reference.

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# Listening reasoning skills





### **Inference making**

The ability to make logical inferences or conclusions based on the information provided in a spoken passage, beyond the explicit statements made.





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#### **Evaluating evidence**

The ability to listen for and evaluate evidence or arguments presented in a spoken passage, assessing their credibility and relevance.



The ability to draw conclusions or make decisions based on the information and evidence presented in a spoken passage, considering different perspectives and possibilities.

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# Analysis of Listening Materials

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# Types and characteristics of listening materials

#### **News reports**

These are reports on current events, providing information on political, economic, social and cultural topics. They are typically concise and accurate, with a focus on facts and figures.

#### Conversations

These are recordings of real-life conversations between native English speakers. They are designed to simulate real-world communication scenarios and focus on practical language usage.

#### **Speeches**

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
