Squamish Outdoor Movies



There are twice as many giant pandas as before. The giant panda is one of the world's most endangered animals. In fact, it is known all over the world as the symbol of the World Wildlife Fund (WWF).



Here is a piece of good news: the number of giant pandas—China's most famous animal—is increasing. The latest facts show that there are now about 1,600 giant pandas living in the wild. That is twice as many as before. Scientists are working hard to find ways to look after these special animals. 85% of the world's giant pandas live in the southwestern hills and mountains of China. Bamboo forests also grow there. Giant pandas mainly feed on bamboo. A research center was set up there to increase the number of giant pandas.



Each day a giant panda spends between 12 and 16 hours eating as much as 20 kilos of food. So in order to better protect giant pandas, in April of 2000, people chose about 23,000 square kilometers of forest in Sichuan, Shanxi and Gansu Provinces to set up nature reserves. There are now over 40 areas to protect giant pandas. Everyone must continue to protect one of China's most important national treasures—the giant panda.
