设计思路	结合仁爱科普版初中英语九年级下册 Unit 5 Topic 1 的课程内容,本节课旨在让学生了解中国丰富的旅游资源,激发他们热爱祖国的情感,同时提高学生的英语阅读和表达能力。课程设计以课本为基础,通过图片、视频、讨论等多种形式,引导学生深入了解中国的自然景观、文化遗产和民俗风情。在教学过程中,注重培养学生的跨文化交际能力,鼓励他们用英语介绍中国的魅力,为今后的国际交流打下基础。

语言能力:通过学习本课内容,学生能够熟练运用本单元所学的词汇和句型,描述中国的旅游景点,并能用英语进行简单的介绍和交流。

核心素 养目标

2. 文化意识:培养学生对中国旅游资源的了解,增强他们对中华文化的认同感和自豪感。

- 3. 思维品质:激发学生的发散性思维,引导他们从不同角度分析和评价中国的旅游资源,提高思维的广阔性和深刻性。
- 4. 学习能力:培养学生自主学习、合作学习和探究学习的能力,提高他们解决实际问题的能力。"

1. 学生已经掌握了基本的英语语法知识和一定量的词汇,能够进行简单的日常交流。在之前的单元学习中,他们已经接触过描述地点和活动的词汇及句型,为学习本课内容奠定了基础。

学习者 分析

- 2. 学生对旅游话题普遍感兴趣,他们喜欢探索不同的文化和风景。在课堂上,学生表现出了较强的合作学习能力和积极参与讨论的意愿。他们的学习风格多样,有的喜欢通过视觉材料学习,有的则偏好听觉和互动式学习。
- 3. 学生可能遇到的困难和挑战包括:对于一些复杂词汇的记忆和使用,以及对旅游景点描述的准确性。此外,由于本课涉及的文化元素较为丰富,学生可能在理解和表达上存在一定障碍。在交流过程中,学生可能会遇到如何流畅使用英语进行复杂句子表达的问题。

教学方法:

- 1. 讲授法:通过讲解中国的旅游景点和相关文化背景,为学生提供必要的信息和知识。

教学方 法与手 段

Good morning, everyone! Today, we are going to learn about Unit 5, China and the world. Specifically, we will explore Topic 1: "China attracts millions of tourists from all over the world." Let's get started!

教学过 程

- 1. **Warm-up and Lead-in**
- **Activity**: Begin with a simple question-and-answer session.

- Me: "Let's share our paragraphs. I will give you feedback and correct any mistakes."
- Students: Share their writing and receive feedback.
- **Purpose**: Improve students' writing accuracy and clarity.
- 10. **Summary and

Reflection**

- **Activity**: Summarize the lesson and reflect on what was learned.
- Me: "Today, we learned about the beautiful places in China that attract tourists. Can anyone tell me what they found most interesting?"
- Students: Share their thoughts and reflect on the lesson.
- **Purpose**: Reinforce the lesson's key points and encourage self-reflection.
- 11. **Homework Assignment**
- **Activity**: Assign homework to reinforce the lesson.
- Me: "For homework, I want you to find a picture of a place in China that you would like to visit and write a short description about it."
- Students: Take note of the homework assignment.
- **Purpose**: Extend learning beyond the classroom and provide additional practice.

12. **Closing**

- **Activity**: End the lesson with a positive note.
- Me: "Thank you for your great participation today. I'm proud of how well you did. Remember to prepare for our next lesson."
- Students: Respond with a positive attitude and prepare for the next class.
- **Purpose**: Encourage a positive learning environment and prepare students for future lessons.

1. 拓展资源:

教学资 源拓展
